Dear St. Andrew Catholic School Families,

Home and School Association

The St. Andrew Catholic Home and School Association is an organization comprised of all parents and guardians of St. Andrew Catholic School students. Their purpose is to promote open communication, goodwill and cooperation among the parents, teachers, and administration by providing an opportunity for parents and teachers to work together for the good of the children. HSA also directs and coordinates parental education and supports St. Andrew Catholic School through assistance activities, social functions and fundraisers.

Membership is open to all parents and guardians of students of St. Andrew Catholic School and the faculty of the school. A voting member shall consist of the entire family unit and the member must be in good financial standing with the association to cast a vote.

We are in the process of looking for the following officers for the 2017-2018 school year:

President

- a. The president shall be the chief executive officer of the association. He/she shall have authority over the general and active management of the business and affairs of the association, subject to the direction of the board.
- b. The president shall call and preside over all regular and special meetings of the association and executive board.

Vice President

- a. Acts as an aide to the President
- b. Performs the duties and exercise the powers of the President in the absence of the President
- c. Performs such duties as assigned by the Home and School Association Board of Directors

Secretary

- a. The secretary shall be responsible for keeping a true and accurate record of meetings of this association and of the executive board.
- b. The secretary shall be responsible for keeping a current and accurate listing of members.
- c. The secretary shall be responsible for notifying all board members of regular or special meetings of the board. He/she shall be responsible for sending notification of regular or special meetings of the association to all members.
- d. He/she shall handle such correspondence as the president or executive board shall direct.

Treasurer

- a. Works with the President to create an annual budget for the Home and School Association
- b. Presents the budget to the Home and School Association Board for approval
- c. Keeps an accurate record of receipts and expenditures

Homeroom Parent (HR) Coordinator

- a. Update and prepare HR Parent notebook for distribution annually to new HR Parents and assist with the HR Parent meeting at the beginning of the school year.
- b. Assist or serve as Chairperson of the Teacher Appreciation Committee and assists with disseminating HSA and other information via HR Parents.

According to our HSA bylaws regarding elections, HSA board members are elected for a 2-year term.

At St. Andrew Catholic School, one of our root beliefs is we serve God by serving others so at the request of our families, we will be offering morning and after school extended care. All students attending morning and or after school care must be registered in the extended care program. The registration fee for extended care is \$20.00 per child.

Morning extended care will begin at 6:30 am-7:00 am for a daily fee of \$1.00 per day of use per child. You must walk your child into the front office and sign them in for morning extended care.

Any child not picked up at the time of dismissal which is 3:00 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, or 2:00 pm on Wednesdays, will automatically be placed in our after school extended care. The daily fee for after school extended care is \$5.00 per day of use per child. After school care ends at 6:00 pm and any child not picked up at this time, will incur a late fee of \$1.00 per minute per child.

If you child is not registered in extended care, the fee for morning extended car is \$2.00 per day per child and the fee for after school extended care is \$10.00 per day per child.

Extended Care fees must be paid weekly or a late fee of \$10.00 will be charged to your account. Any outstanding balances of two weeks will be restricted from attending extended care and will be referred to the School Administration.

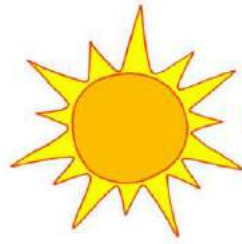
There will be a \$1.00 per minute charge for any student not picked up after 6:00 pm.

Please note:

- Yearly and monthly tuition is paid through the FACTS program. Monthly tuition is paid on the 20th of each month beginning in July. There is a \$36.00 annual Administration Fee charged by the FACTS Program.
- All scholarship award letters must be submitted by July 20th or you will be responsible for monthly payment.
- Any difference between scholarship awards and stated tuition is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- Students with an Early Learning Coalition Child Eligibility Certificate will receive VPK credit for morning.
- St. Andrew also accepts School Readiness (4C). Parent fee set by School Readiness (4C) must be paid weekly.
- 8th Grade students will have a \$250 graduation fee added to their tuition and paid via the FACTS account based on their FACTS payment plan.

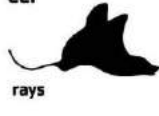

Prerequisites: Must be at least 3 years of age or turning 3 during the time frame of the class.

Prerequisites: Has passed Pike with instructors signature OR is able to jump into shallow end of pool without assistance, can back float for 10 seconds without assistance, can blow bubbles in the water, is able to perform 5 full bobs, swims from wall to flags without assistance.



rays

Prerequisites: Has passed Eel with instructors signature OR is able to jump into deep end of pool without assistance, can roll from front to back and from back to front independently, can blow bubbles out of nose, swim freestyle independently across shallow end, is able to kick on back.

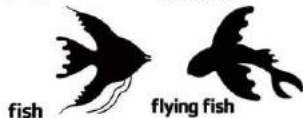
Prerequisites: Must be at least 6 years of age OR is turning 6 during the time frame of the class

Prerequisites: Has passed Polliwog with instructors signature OR can roll from front to back and from back to front independently, is able to consistently streamline off walls, can blow bubbles out of nose, can swim freestyle independently across shallow end, and can swim backstroke independently across shallow end



fish

Prerequisites: Has passed Guppy/Minnow with instructors signature OR is able to dive into deep end is able to consistently rotary breath during freestyle, swims freestyle independently the entire length of the pool, swims backstroke independently the entire length of the pool, swims breaststroke independently across shallow end

Teen/Adult: Ages 13 and up

The focus of this class is basic stroke technique and development for teens and adults with little to no experience with swimming.

Its Raining at my house! Do I still have lessons?
